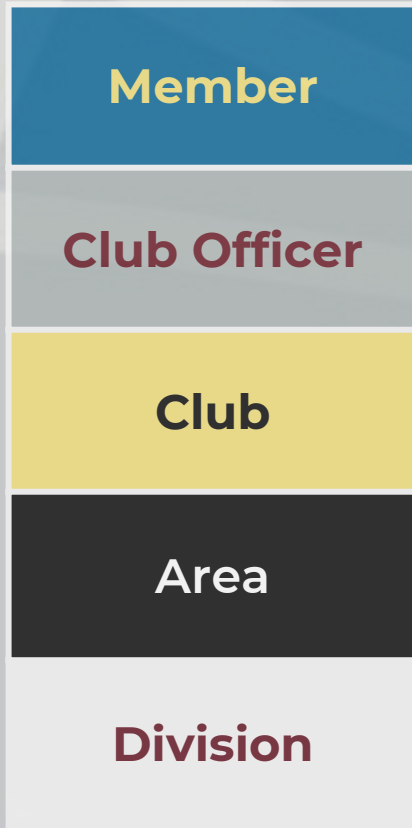


PQ Awards 2022-23
